FAA Home Eligibility Requirements

- Located within the FAA 2022 65 DNL noise contour
- Never been treated or treated prior to 1993
- Constructed before October 1, 1998
- Has not been substantially improved
- Passes an FAA required acoustical pre-test (interior noise level must be 45 dB or greater)
- Based on the 2022 FAA approved Noise Exposure Map, 215 homes and 477 units in East Boston are estimated to be eligible for pre-testing



Sound Insulation Process



The process is a multi-step approach beginning with property research and windshield surveys which will occur over the next few months.

Massport Consultant, Jones Payne Group, will be driving through East Boston neighborhoods conducting exterior property assessments of homes that are potentially eligible.
